

Criteria for Joining the EU-LAC Women's International Network

We invite individuals, as well as representatives of alliances and networks, institutions, or organisations from the European Union (EU) and Latin America and the Caribbean (LAC) committed to gender equality, to join the Network, provided that they:

- Share the mission, vision, and values of the Network.
- Have legal personality in any of the LAC or EU countries or, in the case of individuals, hold the nationality of an LAC or EU country.
- Have experience working in one of the priority action areas of the Network.
- Commit to relevant participation or contribution to at least one initiative per year (examples: preparing a presentation for an event; taking on a moderation role; offering expertise in the development of a publication; writing an article for the EU-LAC Foundation Blog, among others).
- Participate in some of the events organised by the Network and support its dissemination.
- Attend the Network's annual Assembly.
- Establish a focal point within the organisation/institution and authorise the use of the logo for relevant activities (in the case of experts, authorise the use of personal data).
- Share with Network members the programmes, projects, actions, or public policy reports developed by their organisation.

Benefits of Being Part of the Network

- Increased reach and visibility for alliances, institutions, and organisations that develop public policies, initiatives, programmes, practices, and experiences in gender equality within the priority action areas of the Network.
- The possibility of developing and strengthening alliances with public institutions, civil society organisations, and other sectors for joint activities.
- The opportunity to connect with decision-makers and civil society members from both regions to influence agendas that promote more inclusive societies.
- The possibility of publishing opinion articles and contributing to the drafting of public policy reports and analyses based on the expertise and capabilities of the organisation.
- The opportunity to participate as experts and contribute to the successful execution of events organised and promoted by the Network.
