# **BACKGROUND:**

This second European Union-Latin America and The Caribbean Academic Seminar to be held in Lima, Peru on October 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>, 2012, is a preparatory seminar of the EU-LAC Academic Summit to be held in Santiago de Chile on January 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2013, the same week in which the Summit of Heads of State and Government of the sixty state members of the European Union (EU) and the Community of Latin American and Caribbean States (CELAC) will take place in Santiago de Chile (January 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>, 2013).

This will be the seventh time that a meeting of the highest political authorities of the two regions is held. The last meetings were held in Lima (2008) and Madrid (2010). As a complement to this meeting there will be encounters of entrepreneurs, social organizations and NGOs from both regions and now an "Academic Summit" as well.

In this opportunity, on the initiative of a group of academic institutions of Latin America and Europe, an ACADEMIC SUMMIT of Universities and Study and Research Centers from both regions will take place for the first time. This meeting is arranged by the *Centro Latinoamericano para las Relaciones con Europa* (CELARE) and the *Institut des Amériques* of France (IdA), together with an Organizing Committee formed by institutions from both regions.

The Academic Summit will be held in Santiago de Chile on January 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2013, and will provide the Heads of State and Government with a document containing ideas and

proposals about Euro-Latin American relations, especially in the fields concerning their activities.

A very significant aspect in the preparation of the Academic Summit has been the call for two preparatory Seminars. The first one took place in Paris, France, on June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2012 and the second one will take place in Lima, Peru, next October 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>.

The first Seminar gathered over eighty academics from both regions. It was organized by the *Institut des Amériques* of Paris. Its presentations, panels and debates agreed on the importance of holding an Academic Summit and establishing it as a permanent forum which contributes, from their perspective, to the strengthening of the Latin America and The Caribbean and the European Union Association. In this meeting, the Organizing Committee was established with representatives from both regions.

The Summary and Conclusions document of the topics discussed in the Seminar of Paris on June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2012 is attached hereto. This document will provide a basis for reflections and works in Lima.

The second Seminar will allow extending and deepening the analysis and proposals submitted in the Seminar of Paris, as well as the development of the topics to be presented in the Santiago Summit. Therefore, it will be a major milestone in the contribution the academics from both regions must make to the Academic Summit through a document that will be handed over to the CELAC-EU Heads of State and Government.

# PURPOSES AND OBJECTIVES OF THE SECOND PREPARATORY SEMINAR:

The second preparatory Seminar of the EU-LAC Academic Summit will gather in Lima, Peru, Universities, Study and Research Centers, and Professional Colleges of the member states of the European Union and the Community of Latin American and Caribbean States (CELAC), in order to:

- Analyze the EU-LACStrategic Association and, particularly, the cooperation between the two regions in the field of higher education, research, science and technology.
   The following will be particularly reviewed:
  - The EU-LAC relations, generally, its current status, progress, limitations and perspectives.
  - The Euro-Latin American Space of Higher Education.
  - Euro-Latin American Curricular Recognition System, Professional Accreditation and Certification.
  - The EU's Horizon 2020 Framework Program for Science and Technology and the participation of Latin America and The Caribbean.
- Make proposals to be included in the Document the Academic Summit will present in January 2013 to the Summit of Heads of State and Government of the EU and Latin America and The Caribbean (CELAC-EU)
- Issue a Minutes of Lima about Academic Relations between the two Regions.
